- Life skills lessons that include the Real Game (personality profiling highlighting key skills and potential careers areas) and an LMI (Labour Market Information) workshop

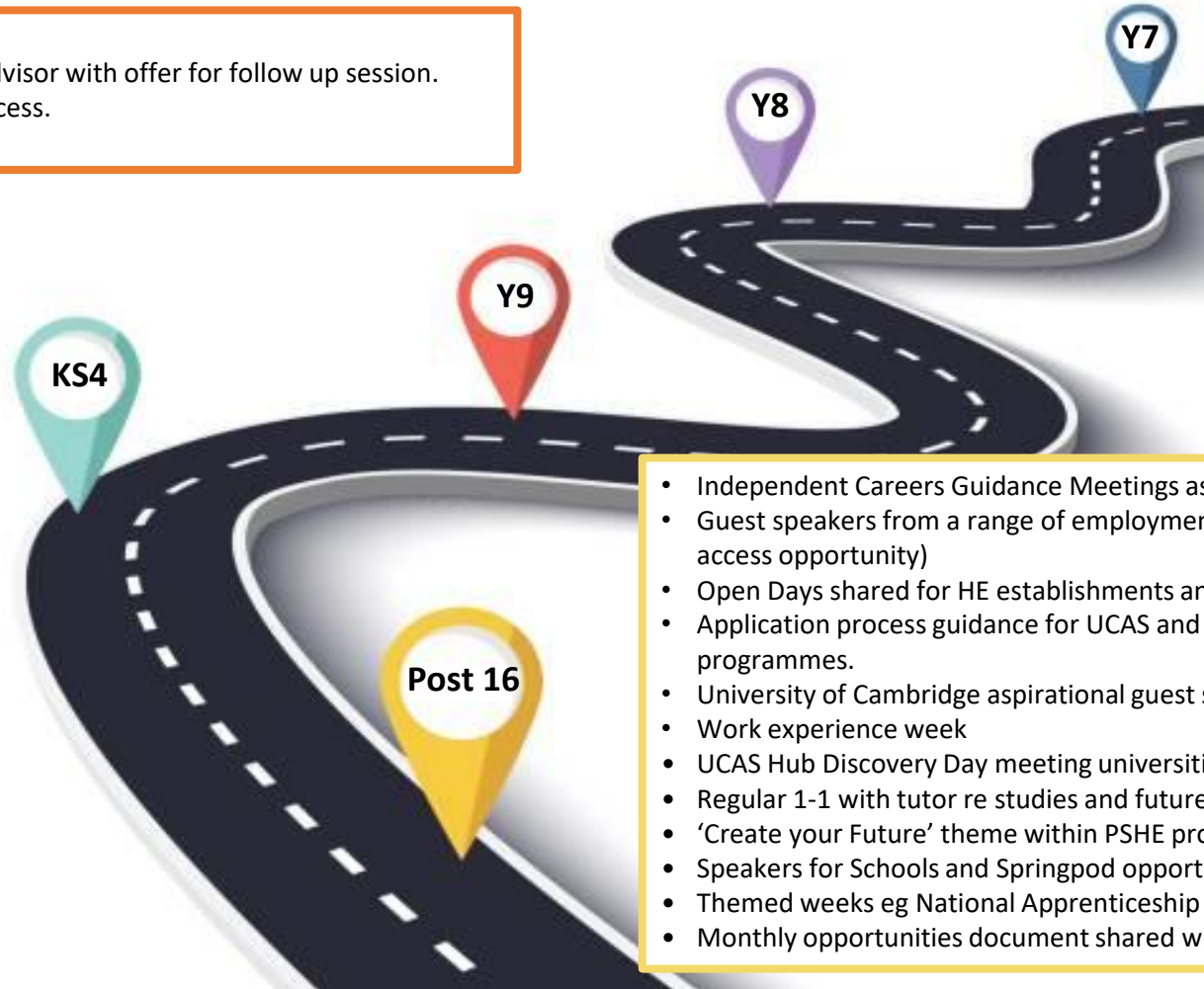
